Calalta FSC, Calgary Ice Cinema, Adult Ice Online & Masters Canadian Ice Dance Theatre are pleased to announce the first ever International Adult Theater On Ice Performance and Workshop, to be held Friday June $28^{th} - 30^{th}$ at Jimmie Condon Arena.

The theme and title for the first year is "A Masquerade Ball". Master Skaters are invited to develop an approximate one to two minute program for the show, to be performed on half ice from the red line to the end of the rink $[100'x\ 100']$. The music and choreography will be the skater's choice and inspiration for the performance can be found on the registration page along with a list of music already spoken for. Performers are encouraged to "recycle" choreography as artists often re-work themes and ideas during the creative process.

The weekend symposium will begin Friday afternoon with a performers solo practice followed by an off-ice and then on-ice rehearsal of the opening and closing numbers. We will break for a working supper and finish the evening with an on-ice run through of the entire show.

Saturday will be a full day; please see the sample schedule. Each day will include working suppers and breakfasts with a panel of experts such as sports psychologists, equipment experts, physiotherapists, acting coaches, exercise specialists and make-up artists to assist the skaters in achieving their personal best performance. The day will finish with a Prosecco & Popcorn Social honouring our sponsors. Costumes for the show will be at the discretion of the skaters but must be **basic black**. Props are encouraged but must be **basic red** in colour. The Artistic Director will assist you with this.
